PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print or type application and Email in with the appropriate fee payable to: The Hispanic International Day Parade of Nevada, Inc., Attention: Parade Coordinator, 212 Antelope Way, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89145.
2. No applications for the parade or payments will be accepted the day of the parade (no exceptions).
3. If you wish to have the "Master of Ceremonies" describe your float or entry in no more than 2 short paragraphs in English and Spanish. You must submit both versions with the application.
4. Businesses sponsoring floats will place a sign no larger than 6'x3' (firmly secured) at the rear of the sponsored float after having paid the business fee in full. Violators will be invoiced with an additional 25% penalty fee.
5. No one will be allowed to throw objects or papers to or at spectators.
6. If you encounter a problem while the parade is in motion, a parade coordinator should be informed immediately.
7. A copy of insurance certificates, if required, must be turned in with the parade application.

PARADE FACTS

- ENTRY:** Complete and return the entry application by September 23, 2011; staging information will be given to accepted entries at the parade information booth prior to the parade.
- FLOATS:** Floats may carry the name of the sponsoring firm or organization in back of the float, in addition to the theme wording. It is desirable for the float theme to be carried out so that it may be seen as it approaches the spectators (i.e., in front as well as on both sides of the float).
- FLOAT DESCRIPTION:** A Float entry must consist of a low trailer, flatbed, or stake bed truck or professionally built chassis. Floats must be completely decorated to the THEME of the parade, including the cab and/or towing vehicle to be considered for a trophy.
- THEME:** *CELEBRATING AMERICA'S CULTURES THROUGH OUR DIVERSITY...OUR STRENGTH!*

JUDGING: Will be by Elected Officials and/or Business People. Decisions of the judges are final.

FLOATS MUST BE IN POSITION BY 9:00 a.m. at Water Street and Ocean Avenue

PARADE WILL START PROMPTLY AT 10:00 a.m.

1. All entries in the parade must be approved by the parade committee; any deviation from the rules of the parade must be approved by the parade committee. Any violation of the parade rules may result in disqualification of applicant.
2. The parade committee accepts no responsibility for false statements made by applicants or entrants.
3. All applications must be in by September 23, 2011.
4. **Check-in booth closing time: 9:00 am; all units must be checked in by this time.**
5. All participants must be uniformed, costumed or appropriately attired.
6. No one under the age of 8 will be permitted to march in the parade without an older companion or special permission granted.
7. Please carry a banner identifying your organization; a parade number will be assigned to each entrant.
8. FORWARD motion must be maintained throughout the parade route.
9. At no time is any unit allowed to throw anything out along the parade route.
10. Shooting of firearms will not be allowed.
11. Sirens or loud noises that interfere with other units will not be allowed.
